Traffic Alert – Saylor Park

Traffic impacts on River Road through July 2024

CINCINNATI – Traffic impacts will occur along River Road in Saylor Park starting in May through July 2024, pending weather and field conditions. The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is installing new regulator structures for combined sewer overflows (CSOs) 402-406.

This project has multiple locations that will be under construction at different times. The following traffic impacts will occur at some point during the construction period:

- Topinabee Road and Catalpa roads will be closed to thru traffic, with a detour in place. Access to local traffic will be maintained but delays could occur. Lane closures will also occur on River Road across from Fernbank Park between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, but traffic will be maintained. A short portion of the walking trail in Fernbank Park will also be impacted.
- Lane closures will occur on River Road between Wilkins Short Road and Revere Avenue between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, but traffic will be maintained.

MSD's contractor, Sunesis Construction, will be constructing new regulator structures at higher elevations that will help reduce the inflow of water from the Ohio River during high water periods. Four of the five CSOs will also be constructed on the north side of River Road, which will allow for future stormwater separation in Saylor Park.

Construction work will generally occur weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Some weekend work may be needed.


In addition to traffic inconveniences, typical construction-related disturbances such as noise, dirt and vibrations should be expected throughout the construction period.



PROJECT AREA MAPS


CSO 402 Map




CSO 403 Map
