Notice of Construction and Traffic Alert for Green Township

Johnson Road Closed to Thru Traffic between Harrison and Reemelin Roads for up to 3 weeks starting Monday, November 24

CINCINNATI – Johnson Road in Green Township will be closed to thru traffic between Harrison and Reemelin roads for up to three weeks starting Monday, November 24, pending weather and field conditions.

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is installing new lateral sewer stubs for five homes along Johnson Road, which will allow the homes to connect to the MSD public sewer system. The project is expected to be completed by spring 2026.

Johnson Road will be closed to thru traffic between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The road will re-open after 6:00 p.m. nightly. Local access to homes along Johnson Road will be maintained, but there could be delays. No work will occur on Thanksgiving Day, and the road will remain open.

MSD's contractor is Empire Excavation, LLC, and they will generally work 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Weekend work may be needed.

The detour route is Harrison Road to Race Road to Reemelin Road and vice versa.

In addition to traffic inconveniences, typical construction-related disturbances such as noise, dirt, and vibrations should be expected.
