Traffic Alert and Notice of Construction for Sedamsville *Westbound River Road Down to One Lane for ~One Month* *Starting Week of March 9*

CINCINNATI – Westbound River Road will be down to one lane starting the week of March 9, for about a month, between Fairbanks Avenue and Mt. Echo Drive in Sedamsville. The project start is weather dependent.

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) is relining a deteriorated sewer in the area. In addition to traffic impacts, temporary non-toxic odors may be present in the area.

Crews will set up the work area, including a sewage bypass system, from March 9-19. To protect the bypass piping, ramps will be placed across River Road that are similar in size and slope to a speed bump.

MSD is relining a 36-inch-diameter sewer along River Road in three locations. This is a trenchless technology, so no excavation work will occur, but the curing process does create non-toxic odors.

The relining work will start at 9:00 a.m. on March 19, March 24, and March 26 and continue into the early morning hours of the next day.

MSD's contractor, Inliner Solutions, will perform the work.
